Udo C. Enwereuzor is a Senior Adviser on Migration, Minorities and Rights of Citizenship at COSPE [*Cooperation for the Development of Emerging Countries*], an Italian NGO engaged in the promotion and protection of human rights and international cooperation.

With an academic background in the natural sciences, he has been engaged in research, consultancy and professional training on migration, equality and rights promotion and protection since 1991. From 1998 to 2001, he served as an expert on the *Commission for Integration Policies* in the Department for Social Affairs, Presidency of the Council of Ministers, Italy. He served also on the management board of the ENAR - *European Network Against Racism*, from its foundation in 1998 until the end of 2002.

From 2001 to the end of 2014, he served as coordinator of the *National Focal Point* (NFP) for Italy of the *RAXEN* and *FRANET* networks, set up by the *European Monitoring Centre on Racism and Xenophobia* (EUMC) and *European Agency for Fundamental Rights* (FRA). He is one of the founding members of the Italian chapter of *SOS Mediterranee*, a European humanitarian organisation that works to save lives of migrants in distress at sea through search and rescue operations (SAR) in the Central Mediterranean.
