Letizia Palumbo is Senior Research Fellow at the Ca Foscari University of Venice (Italy) where she is leader of the work package on human trafficking within the VULNER project – Vulnerabilities Under the Global Protection Regime – funded by Horizon 2020 and led by the Max Planck Institute for Social Anthropology. From December 2019 to June 2020 she was Research Fellow at the EUI, coordinating a research project funded by the Open Society European Policy Institute (OSEPI) on the working conditions of migrant workers in the agricultural sector in Germany, the Netherlands and Sweden. From 2014 to 2019 she was a Research Associate at the EUI, taking part in several projects concerning trafficking and exploitation of migrant workers, in sectors such as agriculture and domestic work. She was Post-Doctoral Researcher in Comparative Private Law at the University of Palermo (2013-2017) and she has been Adjunct Professor also at the University of Palermo. She holds a PhD in Human Rights from the University of Palermo. Her research interests include human trafficking, gender and migration, labour exploitation and human rights.
